Historical Grain Elevator Row Unveiled

Outdoor Watering

Outdoor sprinkling restrictions are in effect at all times in Penhold to promote water conservation. Watering days are based on your property address.

Homes with addresses ending in odd numbers may water on odd numbered days, homes with addresses ending in even numbers may water on even numbered days.

Penhold RV Parking Reminders

Between April 1 and October 15 each year, residents may have their RV parked on the street for 72 hours to park, pack & prepare their RV.

Remember:

- RVs must stay hitched to their tow vehicle, no unhooking on the street.
- After 72 hours, your RV needs to roll to a new spot for at least 48 hours before parking again.

Property Tax Assessment & Notices have been mailed

The 2026 Property Tax combined Notice & Assessments were mailed the first week of May. Property owners who have signed up for E-Billing for property taxes should have received their Notice through E-Mail.

To help residents manage payments more easily, the Town offers the Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP). This option allows taxpayers to make regular monthly payments rather than paying the full amount at once. It's a convenient way to budget and avoid late payment penalties.
