Door-To-Door Sales People are required to register with the Town Office

Door-To-Door solicitors (anyone selling any type of service or product) are required to register with the town and their parent company is required to have a business licence. Please don't hesitate to contact the Town Office to verify a business you are dealing with has a valid business license.

If you feel unsure about the legality of a salesperson, request ID and proof of a licence from the Town of Penhold. Report violators to the Community Peace Officers with an E-Service through the Town website or leave a message at 403-886-3286 or the RCMP non-emergency line.

If you want to avoid solicitation completely, you could put up a "no soliciting" sign at eye level near your front door, gate, or entry way. Use bold text and high contrast colours to make sure it is clearly visible and make sure the material is weather durable.

Our Operations team has begun spring street sweeping in areas where sand and gravel have accumulated over the winter (typically locations where on-street parking isn't permitted). No signage will be required during this initial phase.

Once those areas are complete, crews will move to residential neighbourhoods. When it's your area's turn, "No Parking" signs will be posted the day before sweeping is scheduled.
