REGISTER YOUR PREMISES

Register with Alberta's Premises Identification Program (PID)

APPLY FOR PERMIT / LICENSE

IMPORTANT NOTES

- The intention of the program is to support urban chicken keeping in the Town of Penhold as a hobby and non-commercial activity.
- Licensed urban chicken keepers cannot sell chickens, or any products, produced by one's chicken(s) as they are for personal use only.
- It is in your best interest not to invest in chickens, equipment, etc. until you obtain your permit.
- An application is not a guarantee that you will obtain a permit but instead is a request for a permit.
- The Town of Penhold has the discretion and authority to deny a request for a Permit due to documentation of medical concerns from neighbouring properties and/or any other concerns.
- There is a cap of no more than twenty-five (25) urban chicken sites within the Town of Penhold.
- Outdoor enclosure must be a minimum of eight (8) ten (10) sq. ft.
- · There will be no relaxations permitted.
- The Town of Penhold has the discretion and authority to revoke and/or not renew an urban chicken license.
- Residential areas permissible to house urban chickens include R1, R2, and R4 zoning.

ABOUT THE BYLAW

- Urban Chicken Neighbour Acknowledgement document required in order to obtain license.
- Maximum of 4 urban chickens per property, roosters are not permitted.
- Urban Chicken Keepers are required to pay an annual urban chicken license fee of \$70.00. This is a flat rate fee regardless of number of urban chickens. Urban chicken licenses are valid for the period of Jan. 1 Dec. 31 of the year issued.
- Urban chicken licenses must be renewed annually prior to February 28th of each subsequent year and will not be reduced, prorated, or refunded no matter the month of purchase.
- Urban chicken license holders must produce the license upon request of a Peace Officer.
