Highlights From May 23rd, 2017 Council Meeting

CAO Binnendyk was recognized by Council for receiving the “Award of Excellence” through the Society of Local Government Managers and co-sponsored by Brownlee LLP Barristers and Solicitors. The award was presented to Rick Binnendyk at the Society’s Municipal Administration Leadership Workshop Awards banquet May 18th.

Construction projects for 2017:

- Main Water supply line within Melcor’s ¼ section for access into the new water reservoir is nearing completion.
- Water reservoir access and site preparation is currently underway; completed by the beginning of June.
- The water reservoir project will proceed mid-June. This project will take approx. 12 months.
- Robinson Avenue construction work is set to move forward the beginning of June. (weather dependent)
- The re-construction of an alleyway on the south side of the Palisades Development is currently being developed; anticipated completion the beginning of June.
- Recreational Vehicle Park anticipated start date is July.

Penhold Crossing Plaza is currently under construction; a commercial building comprised of seven bays forms part of the development; including a drive-thru establishment and convenience store as a separate building.

Town of Penhold and Red Deer County has a public meeting on June 15th to discuss the Inter municipal Development Planning document for the Town and the rural surrounding area.

Spring Clean-up Week begins May 25th to June 5th. This is a great way to get rid of stuff that has been sitting around the house. Another opportunity to de-clutter your home is the “Kick it to the Curb” event being held on May 26th – 28th.

The Community Garage Sale is being held on May 27th. The format for this event is each home can set up their own items for sale at their residence. You can contact Mel at the Town Office to register your garage sale and a list of homes having garage sales will be compiled. Citizens are invited to participate in a garage sale scavenger hunt visiting at least five garage sales around town collecting a secret word. Once you have collected five of the words you can return to the Multiplex to enter the draw between 11:00am – 2:00pm.

Council approved the signing of an Amending Memorandum of Agreement with the Province to obtain Municipality Sustainability Initiative (MSI) funding for a further two year period.

Council requested Administration to connect with South Red Deer Regional Waste Water Commission asking for information on what appears to be an odor concern and what is the Commission doing to address the problem.
