

# Public Skating Rules



## DO

- Anyone under 16 must wear a helmet while on the ice
- Wheelchairs, strollers and skating aids are permitted with the accompaniment of a responsible person on skates
- Wheels must be cleaned prior to entering the ice surface
- Helmets are required for stroller and wheelchair occupants
- Skate in the direction of all skaters

## DON'T

- Shoes, boots not allowed on the ice
- Tag or games
- Food and beverages not permitted on ice or in the benches
- Chairs are not permitted on the ice
- No carrying children while on the ice (including baby carriers)
- No figure skating maneuvers
